Report

My [experience](#) and my [training](#) in the merchant navy gave me a good understanding of the programmes and, above all, the purpose of the 250 kW and 750 kW mechanic training courses.

The main challenge for a beginner teacher is to create courses in a short space of time. I found that serious preparation of lessons and exercises took between three and four hours for a beginner trainer. For a course prepared by another teacher, this time can be reduced to around two hours. The course must contain a lot of practical exercises. Another lesson learned is that only a minority of students are able to take notes. For the majority of students, a handout should give an outline of the lesson.

The Jacques Cassard vocational school offers an excellent environment for quality teaching. Students in the Continuing Education programme are almost all highly motivated and disciplined.
